

Favourable EIS report

THE \$628 million Northeast Business Park (NBP), at Morayfield, is a step closer with the State Coordinator-General giving the development's environmental impact statement (EIS) conditional approval.

State Planning Minister Stirling Hinchliffe said the report concluded the project's environmental impacts could be managed with conditions.

The Coordinator-General Colin Jensen's final report will now go to the Federal Environment Minister to assess matters of national environmental significance.

The NBP proposal includes 169ha of industry and businesses, a 911-berth marina, restaurants, public areas and homes, and about 420ha of open space including a golf course.
