MORETON Bay councillors talk about the damage a marina development and dredging of the Caboolture River will cause when Mayor Allan Sutherland's own family home is on a developed canal block which has been clearly dredged into Moreton Bay.

Why is it only now we hear of council's concern of the waterways and foreshores of Moreton Bay when it has been aware of the North East Business Park project for the last four years?

Since the amalgamation three years ago, the rate-
