Businesses to seek answers on project

MORE than 150 people are expected to attend tomorrow's Commerce Caboolture meeting - at which Mayor Allan Sutherland and Deputy Mayor Greg Chippendale will outline council's opposition to part of the Northeast Business Park (NEBP) development.

Moreton Bay Regional Council and NEBP have been locked in Planning and Environment Court proceedings over council's rejection of the park's marina and residential development.

Council's concerns surround proposed dredging of the Caboolture River.

Commerce Caboolture president Michelle Lember said the meeting would give the business community a chance to understand council's position on NEBP.

"The Northeast Business Park project was considered by many among the business community as a saviour of sorts, an economic boom

bringing jobs to kick-start spending, and workers to buy/rent local properties," Ms Lember said.

"When it didn't proceed and showed no signs of doing so, our members began asking council officers attending our dinners where the project was at, as some mem-

bers considered that the project would sit well within council's promotion of the Local Jobs for Local People campaign."

Senior NEBP figures are also expected to attend the meeting, starting at 6.30pm tomorrow at the Centenary Lakes Function Centre.
